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1 2nd On-line Training Program

Advancing EU-Turkey high-level dialogue on climate action including technical exchanges and trainings on EU ETS

This second on-line training program represents the final activity of the broader capacity building program funded by the EU within the EUCD project.

It is designed for Türkiye Climate Change Presidency members, engaged in the implementation and management of the national pilot ETS, for the other key State institutions involved and for the private sector subject to ETS regime, once in force.
